With this strong conviction, CVCS has embarked on implementing an awards program that will recognize outstanding public involvement efforts on a group (Section/Branch) basis as well as on an individual basis. The following two awards will be presented in each of the four zones:

- **ASCE Public Service Award**, presented to an organized component within ASCE (Section, Branch, YM Group, Committee)

The awards will be presented during the 2006 Zone Leadership Conferences as follows:

- Zone I – February 10-12, 2006 in Boston
- Zone II - January 27-29, 2006 in Tampa
- Zone III – February 17-19, 2006 in Houston
- Zone IV – January 13-15, 2006 in Salt Lake City
