Keith Kesner, Ph.D., P.E., is an Associate with Whitlock Dalrymple Poston & Associates, P.C., and currently heads the South Norwalk, Connecticut office. Dr. Kesner participates in various structural projects, which include the evaluation of structures using nondestructive test methods, corrosion evaluations, structural analysis using both conventional and finite element methods, as well as development of technical plans and specifications for the repair and rehabilitation of structures.

Prior to joining WDP, Dr. Kesner was Project Director with the Thornton Tomasetti Group in New York where he was involved in structural analysis and the repair and rehabilitation of structures experiencing distress.

Dr. Kesner was also an instructor/post-Doctoral researcher at Cornell University. He is a licensed civil engineer in Virginia, New York, California (Civil), and Connecticut. Dr. Kesner's education includes a Ph.D. in Civil Engineering in 2003, Master of Science in Civil Engineering in 1998, both from Cornell University, and a Bachelor of Science in 1992 from The University of Connecticut.

Dr. Kesner is actively involved in several professional organizations, including the American Society of Civil Engineers, American Concrete Institute (named a Fellow in 2007), and the International Concrete Repair Institute (ICRI). Dr. Kesner received the 2005 American Concrete Institute (ACI) Young Member Award and was a co-recipient of the 1998 ACI Construction Practice Award. He is also a recipient of the 2002 ICRI Outstanding Project Award – Project of the Year, Marina del Rey Seawall Project and the 2000 ICRI Outstanding Project Award – Longevity Category 2000, Repair of the Champion International Parking Structure. Dr. Kesner serves on several ACI committees. He has authored or co-authored over 80 technical papers and presentations for industry journals and is a regular speaker at industry conferences.
